# FROM THE ASSISTANT MINISTER



Dear St Andrew's,

In light of my sermon last Sunday, I thought I'd take this further opportunity to encourage you to think about small group participation. From my experience, everyone who joins a small group finds the experience and fellowship very encouraging.

As I explained last Sunday, with a growing church, the role of small groups becomes increasingly important in caring for others, and being cared for. In essence, we hope small groups will become the centre of pastoral care; little communities of love and social engagement. A place where people can share

their joys and their struggles in a safe environment, while allowing God to speak to us as we read and discuss his word.

Additionally, small group participation presents the opportunity for individuals to use their gifts and talents in the service of others.

We currently have around half the church in small groups, which is terrific, but I would love to see that increase. To make it easy for you, I have included a list of all the groups, showing their location, and meeting times. As you can see, we have both morning and evening groups, single-sex and mixed groups, congregational specific and mixedcongregation groups.
