Praise God that Andrew's back is feeling much better thanks to a TENS machine which Meredith Dimarco kindly sent. He can wear it during the day and can get some relief.

Pray for the need next year from July for two or three teachers to replace the Pocknalls; pray that the right people will be available.

Pray also that now there is a bank account, the Bishop will approach the owners of the adjoining properties to see if they are willing to sell their land for the school to use. The school currently has about half an acre and they need a further 2 acres to run a proper primary school. As there are six properties around them totalling around 2 acres, pray that all six property owners are willing to sell.

Continue to pray for their safety on the roads and good health.
