PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE

The general offertory received for the 7 months through to the end of July 2014 totals \$474,628. This compares with our budgeted general offertory for the same period totalling \$507,500.

We are currently \$32,872 behind budget as at the end of July. It has been encouraging to see a lift in regular giving but we are still short of the amount we collectively approved at the AGM.
