☛ Fit for Good – Pilates

Did you know that St Andrew's runs 2 weekly Pilates classes at the church as part of its Fit for Good ministry?

A Monday evening class (5.30-6.30pm) is run by Katy Wiseman and a Friday lunchtime class (11.15am -12.15pm) by AngieBlack.

Both classes are suitable for people of all ages and fitness levels. Men and women, from couch potatoes to professional athletes can benefit from Pilates programs which improve posture and flexibility and increase core strength. All equipment is provided.

Both Katy and Angie are professional fitness instructors. The cost of the classes are \$120 for a term of 10 lessons, itself a very reasonable price; but here's the good news... Katy and Angie give their time for free!

So all the money they receive goes to charity. This year those exercising have contributed almost \$3,500 to Anglican Aid and the Archbishop Fund. A big thank you to all concerned!

STEPHANIE AND ANDREW BROWNING



📍 Tanzania

Pray for Stephanie and Andrew Browning with children William and Christopher in Arusha, Tanzania where Andrew works at the Lutheran Mission Hospital as a surgeon. Stephanie has been involved in setting up a school for local children with the help of the Bishop.

Andrew is grateful for those who prayed for his back surgery, that it is about 50% better, which means he still can't drive far but can operate more easily. Since his return he has visited Ethiopia first to Barhidar where plans are being finalised for the new hospital. Pray for another \$150,000 needed to complete it. While there he was able to do an emergency caesarean in the temporary theatre. Pray for Birhanu who is director of the unit and give thanks that he has a

sponsor for him to study medicine. He will be the doctor there in the future.

Andrew also went to Addis Ababa Fistula Hospital to help with training and also assist with operating on some young fistula patients from Afar.

He has also been to a fistula camp in Nairobi Kenya where 120 women were treated in two weeks.

Back in Arusha, pray for the Muslim lady, Hadija, who is waiting for a caesarean and who has been listening to a megavoice (a gospel story on a solar powered audio device) saying that it has only been Christians who cared for her.

Pray for the school term which started last week with 32 students. Thank God for a volunteer teacher from Canada who will take the younger children and Stephanie is taking the older children. Pray for the need for extra teaching space in the coming months. Stephanie is negotiating with the Diocese as to how to resolve this urgent need.

Rick and Jenny Hooper will arrive this week and start teaching next week. They have three children, Ben 7, Matthew 5, and Adam 3. They will be great mates for William and Christopher.
