🔦 Spotlight on Uganda

Pray for the continued leadership of AE Uganda, established in 1971, to win people to Jesus.

Pray for the leadership team of AE Uganda as Edward Mubiru takes over the role as acting team leader from Paul Ssembiro who is now Chaplain at Uganda Christian University. Also for Eva Kadi who joined AE Uganda as the new National Coordinator.

Give thanks and pray for AE Chairman Rev. Dr John Senyonyi in his governance and leadership roles within Uganda.

Pray with thanks for the support from Australia that enabled many hundreds of pastors to be trained in the George Whitfield Explore program. Please pray for continued and strong growth and education opportunities for pastors.

In the month of World Health Day please pray for those suffering illness and disease across Africa.

For the mission work that focusses on districts of Kampala with high slum populations and overcrowding, pray that the work of AE will give hope through word and deed.

Pray against witchcraft in Uganda, where some 3 million witchdoctors practice, some of whom engage in child sacrifice.

Pray for the 3.1 million Ugandans who have been pushed into poverty due to the disruption on the economy caused by COVID-19.

Pray for the 12,000 families in Tanzania and Uganda that have been displaced by oil projects taking place on their land.

70% of Ugandans are under 25 years. Please pray that through a mission to Jinja in partnership with the Nile Vocational Institute that many young adults will be transformed through the love of Christ.

Pray for the wellbeing, physical and spiritual health of the staff and patients at the Milne Medical Clinic in Kampala that provides general and maternity care.

Pray for the outreach to refugees at the Bidi Bidi camp in Northern Uganda and for the agencies involved in the care of those displaced.
