*As the rain and the snow come down from heaven,
and do not return to it without watering the earth
and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed
for the sower and bread for the eater, so is my word
that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me
empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve
the purpose for which I sent it. (Isaiah 55:10-11)*

Give thanks as His Word goes out across Africa and for equipping God's workers in the harvest field. Pray that AE's home based evangelism initiatives, and social action initiatives, will accomplish what the Lord desires.

Pray for upcoming missions in Mombasa West, Kenya, Kayonza in Rwanda (re-scheduled due to a volcanic eruption in DRC), and Mont-Amba in DRC that will focus on mobilisation, equipping and training in home based evangelism.

Pray also for mission, training and strategic planning events in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania as part of the Dar Back-to-God Mission, Jinja and Entebbe in Uganda, Zomba in Malawi, Lome in Togo and Kotebe in Ethiopia (N/E of Addis Ababa).

Pray for the self-help group (SHGs) programs that continue to transform the lives of hundreds of thousands of Rwandese. As well as increasing economic activity in communities, bringing social cohesion and purpose, improving nutrition and education for children, the SHGs have been a conduit for vital health messaging during COVID-19.
