INDIGENOUS WARLPIRI PEOPLE



📍 **Tanami Desert, Northern Territory**

Pray for World Vision as they work with the Warlpiri indigenous communities in the Northern Territory.

Praise God for high levels of community engagement on planned early childhood activities for 2015 across all communities.

Praise God for successful action taken by the Lajamanu Early Childhood Reference Group to communicate and clarify for Lajamanu families what services and options are available. This has resulted in higher engagement. One highlight has been a teenage mother who has started volunteering while her son is in the childcare program.

Please pray for the new team members; that they will settle in well and that a strong sense of team will be developed.

Pray that God's Spirit will go before the team and the project as new activities start to be planned.

Pray for:

- wisdom for the project staff and communities so that they might continue to be effective.
- parents and caregivers in all of the communities; for God's strength, wisdom and provision to be able to provide the things that young children need to thrive.
- the 'witness' of the project; that children and families participating will experience God's love through the way the leaders work.
- the Channels of Hope workshops in late March where 35 indigenous Church leaders will come to hear more about how Channels of Hope works.
