# FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

### Senior Minister

Dear St Andrews,

Please note that our **Annual General Meeting** is on Monday 23 March at 7pm. Please make every effort to come.

Key items of the AGM include a report about the *2020 Vision*, discussion of the budget, an important update about the property development, and election of Parish Council, Wardens, and Parish Nominators. We have been asking you for the last few weeks to think and pray about who might be nominated to these important positions.

Parish Nominators are five people charged with finding a new Senior Minister should the existing one 'depart'. God willing, they will be doing nothing for many years, but it is essential that we select a trusted group of godly people every year. The Nominators currently proposed (who have been nominated for this position) are Cath Ahern, John Campbell, Andrew Marks and Annette Ware.

The Parish Council (usually six elected persons) is charged by the Diocese with the *governance* of the parish's property and finance. They also assist the Senior Minister in overseeing all ministry. It is quite a role! The

six people so far nominated for this role are Andrew Berriman, Angie Black, Elizabeth Clark, Andrew Loel, Andrew Wiseman and Alban Wong.

The three Wardens (two elected by the parish, one appointed by me) also sit on the Parish Council. They both govern and *administer* the property and finances of the Parish. They also provide key counsel to the Senior Minister. The two wardens so far nominated are Craig Taylor and Andrew Killen. It is my intention to appoint Philip Bell as a Warden.

Please continue to pray about these important positions, and make sure you come to the AGM to offer your contribution to the proper functioning of the St Andrew's. Anyone can attend the AGM. To vote, however, you must be 18 years or over, be baptised (in any Christian denomination), and have attended our church for at least the last three months. I love the way the Anglican Church has the 'lowest bar' for membership imaginable!
