The popularity and value of these groups is found not only in the study of the Bible, but also the genuine care and concern the members of the groups have for one another. These are places where we forge authentic relationships, where we encourage each other to grow as disciples living in the real world—where truth meets life!

Most of the groups follow the sermon series but a new group has been just set up to explore the basics of Christian faith for those who would benefit from this grounding and/or are new to studying the Bible.
