This three-part course introduces newcomers to the life and ministry of St Andrew's. The most recent course ran on 3 consecutive weeks, finishing last Sunday.

Over afternoon tea, Senior Associate, Matt Stedman, and Assistant Minister, James Smith have led the participants through some of the key ideas and beliefs of St Andrew's. They were introduced to other members of staff, including: Senior Minister, John Dickson, who outlined our 2020 Vision; Executive Pastor, Santino Dimarco, who explained our finances, operations and property plans; and several of our Pastoral Workers, who talked about their roles and ministry opportunities in the church and the wider community.

So far this year over 20 newcomers have "graduated" from Belonging and have found the course "very beneficial in getting an overview of St Andrew's" and "a great way to feel more part of the church."

Finally, a big thank you to those who have opened up their homes, catered or made guest appearances at this course.
