## ST ANDREW'S MINISTRY UPDATE

### 👉 **ESL (English as a Second Language)**

For 12 years now St Andrew's has been running ESL classes. Currently up to 20 students from Japan, China and Korea with basic to good English meet every Thursday morning (10am-noon) during school terms, with mothers leaving their young children at our playgroup. Our 6 teachers aim to improve the students' conversation skills, grow their confidence and develop friendships..

Each class finishes with a Bible study and prayer, and St Andrew's staff regularly give talks to help integrate the students into the wider life of St Andrew's. An example of this was the involvement of ESL students in the All Nations BBQ lunch after the 10am service last Sunday. Further activities include regular excursions and monthly craft days at the home of Jane Clifford, who co-ordinates this valuable ministry.

The students appreciate not only their language learning but also belonging to a community of support and encouragement. ESL classes are such a great way to show the love of Christ to those who are often new to the gospel as well as to Australia.
