FINANCIAL UPDATE

JULY 2015

➔ Offertory

It is pleasing to be able to report that for the 7 months to the end of July 2015 the general offertory is now only slightly behind budget. The budget required general offertory for the 7 month period to equal \$545,563 and the amount actually received was \$545,240.

You may recall that at the end of April we were \$50,000 behind budget. There are several contributing factors that have helped us reduce this shortfall:

- i. several generous and significant one-off gifts;
- ii. the re-introduction of the offertory collection during each of the contemporary Sunday services; and
- iii. an increase by some in the amount of their regular electronic contributions.

The receipt of the one-off gifts, which totalled approximately \$40,000, clearly has helped us meet budget to July. This however, may mean that the amount of *regular* monthly giving, though on the increase, may not yet be sufficient to keep us on budget through to the end of December.

Whether you are already giving regularly or you haven't yet commenced regular gifts, please prayerfully consider how much you are able to invest in the work of your church, as it ministers the gospel to the community of Roseville and beyond.



Also included in this calculation are the funds distributed to organisations from our annual Foundation Day, eg in 2014 to World Vision (Warlpiri), Asian seminaries, Anglican Aid - Ebola crisis, and StreetWork.
