FINANCIAL UPDATE

AUGUST 2015

☛ Offertory

After reporting that the general offertory was only slightly behind budget for the 7 months up to the end of July, the general offertory for August was below budget. The amount received in August totalled \$72,560 against a budget of \$77,900; a shortfall of \$5,340. **As a result, the general offertory for the 8 months up to the end of August is now \$5,700 behind budget.**

Given that at the end of April we were \$50,000 behind budget, the response to reducing the shortfall was wonderful and very much appreciated. Many gave additional amounts as one-off gifts to reduce the shortfall and some have increased their regular giving or commenced giving regularly; so to be only \$5,700 behind budget at the end of August is a huge improvement.

The concern however is that regular monthly giving is still approximately \$5,300 per month less than budgeted. If this monthly shortfall continues for the remainder of the year, we will end the year **around \$27,000 behind budget.**

Whether you are already giving regularly or you haven't yet commenced regular gifts, please prayerfully consider how much you are able to invest in the work of your church, as it ministers the gospel to the community of Roseville and beyond.


