📍 Tanzania

Stephanie and Andrew Browning with children William and Christopher are serving in Arusha, Tanzania where Andrew works at the Lutheran Mission Hospital and Stephanie has set up a Christian School.

Please pray for rain for Tanzania. The country has shut all its hydro-electric power stations and they only have electricity for around 3-4 hours per day, usually from 2am. It is very difficult to run a hospital with no electricity. There is also next to no water too - an even more difficult problem.

Praise God that Stephanie was able to return to Australia in time for her Grandmother's funeral.

Pray that work permits will be granted for the new teachers at the school and also that Andrew can get the permits for their doctors working in Ethiopia.

Praise God for a couple of recent trips to Uganda by Andrew and pray for all the patients that were treated there. Pray for Christ's light in that place particularly given some disturbing activity by local witch doctors across the road from where Andrew was sleeping.

Pray for safe elections in Tanzania next weekend; that it will be peaceful and a godly person is elected as leader.
