## PROPERTY REDEVELOPMENT UPDATE

On Friday the Joint Regional Planning Panel (JRPP) of the NSW Government handed down their determination relating to the Development Application (DA) for our church redevelopment.

Unfortunately, the JRPP had not received their own legal advice regarding their authority on Floor Space Ratio (FSR) matters as they advised they would do at the conclusion of the previous JRPP meeting in July. Therefore they were not in a position to make a determination. They also requested another site visit to refresh their understanding of the development issues.

Whilst this is a disappointing result, we will continue to work with the JRPP and our consultants so that a decision can be handed down as soon as possible; we do not expect a decision before next March.

We thank God for his continued provision for our church community as we seek to serve the community of Roseville and beyond.

Please continue to pray that God will provide the answers to these issues so that we can turn our plans into reality.
