FROM THE ACTING RECTOR

This Sunday we begin a 4 week series on the word 'Grace'.

It is one of the most meaningful words the Biblical authors use to describe God's attitude to his creation. It comes up often. So much, that sometimes we may be in danger of missing its potency and beauty as a description of God's mercy, forgiveness and kindness. The Bible's word 'grace' is especially associated with God's offer of salvation to the world.

Last weekend we celebrated the events of Good Friday and Easter. We were acknowledging God's gracious gift of sending his Son to die for our sins and then raising him up from death to demonstrate his triumph over death. This is an utterly free and undeserved offer to humankind of forgiveness and new life. It is God's grace on display; pure and undefiled.

The word has numerous aspects and in order to touch upon those variations on a theme, the focus of the sermons are:

- Grace in the Old Testament
- Grace in salvation.
- Grace in obedience
- 4. Grace in community

I reckon the most frequent use of the word 'grace' on our lips is the blessing or commendation we offer to one another at the end of many of our church services: 'The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ; the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all.'

Those words contain a mountain of meaning and at some time, deserve unpacking.

But the use of the word 'grace' that especially resonates with me is when it is used by St John in the opening words of his Gospel. In his opening words, John is emphasising the divine origins and the divine character of Jesus, the Son of God.

John has already signalled Jesus' supernatural status by giving him the title, 'The Word'. Then a little lower he uses these words:

'The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.' (John 1.14)

The words, 'truth' and 'grace' describe God himself. So, in other words, Jesus is full of the character of God.

There is the high status of this beautiful Christian word. The phrase, 'full of grace', perfectly describes Jesus. So for us to display Jesus' character we act 'graciously' towards each other.
