Please pray for John Dickson as he films scenes for the forthcoming Centre for Public Christianity documentary, *For the Love of God: How the Church is Better and Worse Than You Ever Imagined*, a four-part history of the terrible and beautiful aspects of Christian history, including the Crusades, the Inquisitions, support for slavery, etc., as well as the origins of charities, hospitals, universal education, and human rights. With three hosts and 40 expert interviews, John delivers the scenes covering the ancient and early medieval period. The planned itinerary for the next two weeks is as follows:

**16-17 Oct:** London, British Museum, scenes about the ancient view of humanity and the Jewish idea of the 'image of God'.

**17-19 Oct:** Athens and Delphi (Greece), scenes related to Graeco-Roman ethics and philosophy, the origins of humility, and the Christian call to charity.

**19-23 Oct:** Rome and Ostia (Italy), scenes covering the persecution of Christians, the origins of the 'hospital', Christian welfare programs, the expansion of Christianity, and the development of 'just war' theory.

**23-27 Oct:** Jerusalem, West Bank, Galilee, Caesarea (Israel), scenes covering Old Testament violence, Jewish resistance fighting, Jesus' ethic of love and non-violence, and the 11-12th century Crusades.

**30 Oct:** Roseville, preaching on Acts 15, arguably the most significant 'council' in history.
