### 📍 Tanzania

Andrew and Stephanie Browning with children William and Christopher are serving in Arusha, Tanzania where Andrew works at the Lutheran Mission Hospital and Stephanie has set up and runs the Christ Church International School.

Praise God that over the last few months, with nearly 600 deliveries, there have been no maternal deaths and only one still born baby. These are results that would make an Australian hospital proud; and all in a tin shed. Pray that this kind of success will continue!

Pray for Drs Margaret and Yohannes as they soldier on under great difficulties in the hospital in North Eastern Ethiopia.

There has been some civil unrest in Ethiopia and many hundreds of people have been killed. There has been some violence in Bahir Dar so please pray for our staff. The volunteers coming for November and December have pulled out so we are making an agreement with the local university to place junior obstetricians. Pray that they will respect our policies and the way the midwives work. Please pray for the new hospital in being built in Arusha, Tanzania. Recently, Andrew and his team were part of an amazing prayer walk around the property with some missionary friends from South Africa.

Pray for the Christ Church International School in Arusha. Praise God that that Stephanie was able to buy the new house in time for the school year to begin. There are many new students as well. Pray for funds as Steph has started building four new classrooms and still needs funds to complete it.
