Dear St Andrew's,

This **Monday evening at 7pm is our Annual General Meeting**. Please come.

We will elect crucial office holders, hear reports about the ministry of the last year, receive the 2016 audited financial accounts and consider the proposed 2017 budget, be updated about the property redevelopment, and recalibrate for another year of pursuing our *2020 Vision* to pull down the barriers between church and society and *offer a centre of community to Roseville and beyond*.

Please be in prayer for those who have been nominated for the various offices. So far, the nominations are:

Parish Council: Tori Grimes, Andrew Loel, Sebastian McIntosh, Kylie Roberts, Andrew Wiseman and Alban Wong. As Rector, assuming that the size of the elected Parish Council remains at 6 I will also appoint 2 additional Parish Councillors (ie for every 3 elected Parish Councillors, as Rector I am able to appoint 1 person).

Wardens: Craig Taylor and Andrew Killen. It is my intention to appoint Philip Bell as a the Rector's Warden.

Parish Nominators: Cath Ahern, John Campbell, Bill Hurditch, Andrew Marks and Richard Seton.

Please make sure you come to the AGM to offer your contribution to the proper functioning of St Andrew's. Anyone can attend the AGM. To vote, however, you must be 18 years or over, be baptised (in any Christian denomination), and have attended our church for at least the last three months.

There will also be time for Q&A, and we will record any of your recommendations for the consideration of the incoming Parish Council.

All in 73 minutes (that's a prediction not a promise).

THE LORD'S PRAYER


Our Father in heaven,
