LIFE OF JESUS COURSE

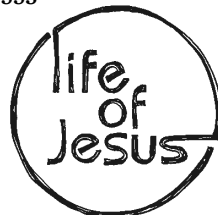
🕒 *A four-week course that digs deeper into

ARCHBISHOP MASIMANGO KATANDA



📍 Congo

Pray for Archbishop Masimango Katanda in the Anglican Church in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Pray for Masimango in his role as the Archbishop of the Congo. Pray for wisdom and energy in his various responsibilities as he seeks to teach and encourage those around him. Pray also for Archbishop Masimango's family as he begins his new role.

Pray for the Democratic Republic of Congo. There has been much unrest and two years of brutal political repression leading up to and following the December 19, 2016, deadline that marked the end of President Joseph Kabila's constitutionally mandated two-term limit. Pray for the participants in talks mediated by

the Catholic Church. The talks lead to a signed agreement on New Year's Eve 2016, including a commitment that presidential elections will be held before the end of 2017, that the current President will not seek a third term, and that there will be no referendum nor changes to the constitution. Pray that these agreements will hold.

Pray for Archbishop Masimango as he seeks to care for those around him and to be a leader in a very difficult time for the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Pray that the church will provide stability and be able to bring peace in this troubled country.
