## INTERNATIONAL NEPAL FELLOWSHIP



### ➔ Nepal

*The International Nepal Fellowship (INF) is a Christian mission that serves the physical and spiritual needs of poor and disadvantaged Nepali people, and supports the Nepali church. Over the years, St Andrew's has sent workers to serve with INF, while also supporting the work financially and in prayer.*

Pray for INF's Green Pastures Hospital, where new wards have recently been completed, and the foundation stone laid for a chapel in the hospital. The chapel is a key part of the re-development and signifies the importance of Christ being at the centre of all that INF does, and at the heart of INF's vision.

Give thanks for the generosity that allowed this building work to take place, and pray that God's spirit would be very present there, and

that every patient and visitor, staff member and volunteer would have an opportunity to know Jesus.

Pray for INF's work in the remote hill areas of Nepal to improve the livelihoods of women and children. Pray that staff would use every opportunity they are given to share 'the reason for the hope that they have', and that as people's physical situations are improved, that God would also be glorified.

Pray for all mission organisations working in Nepal as the government limits work visas and restricts church outreach activities. Pray for freedom of religion, but also that Nepali Christians would be bold in sharing their faith and that their love for Jesus would shine through any persecution.
