INTERNATIONAL NEPAL FELLOWSHIP



📍 Nepal

The International Nepal Fellowship (INF) is a Christian mission that serves the physical and spiritual needs of poor and disadvantaged Nepali people, and supports the Nepali church. Over the years, St Andrew's has sent workers to serve with INF, while also supporting the work financially and in prayer.

Pray for the people of Nepal in the coming month. There are major Hindu festivals during October with sacrifices made to the gods and times of family celebration. It is often hard for Christians who are rejected by their families and communities. Pray that the Hindus of Nepal will come to know Jesus as the one true sacrifice for their sins. Pray for encouragement and wisdom for Nepali Christians during this time; that they will be good witnesses to Jesus, even in the face of persecution. Also pray for Nepali churches organising outreach events and youth camps during the festivals; for safety, and that God will speak through them.

Pray for a new INF initiative this year to help Nepali churches reach out to people with disabilities. Workshops are being held to give Pastors a biblical perspective on disability so that all people are recognised as being loved by God and made in his image. Pray that this will be an effective outreach to the wider community.
