## THE LORD'S PRAYER

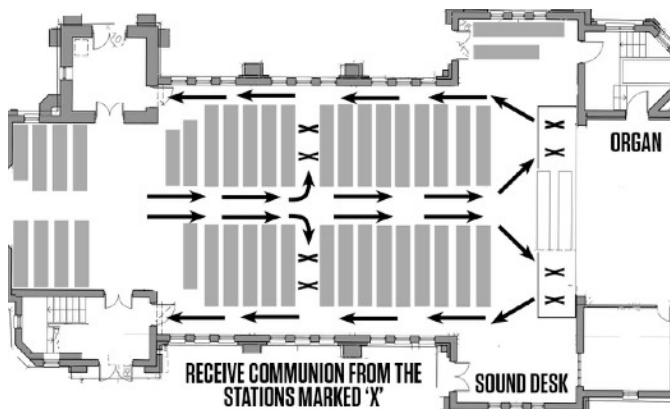
Our Father in heaven,
