

## • New book for a great cause

Glenn Daniel from our 5pm congregation has just released his first book, 'News Time – A Life in Radio'. The book looks back at Glenn's 35 years in news and broadcasting from 1982 to 2017.

100% of the proceeds from the sale of the book are going to the Cardiac Research Unit at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital. The RPA team is a world leader replacing heart valves without open-heart surgery. In 2011, Glenn himself had open-heart surgery. The Cardiac Research Unit have achieved incredible results with patients out of hospital in 3-4 days.
