# FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

## REV JOHN DICKSON

#### **O** Senior Minister

Dear St Andrew's.

Between 1913 and 1958, the courageous members of St Andrew's Roseville built the original church (1913), added a major extension (1920), pulled everything down and built the current church building (1935), and then constructed the current hall next door (1958). Since 1958, we have done nothing on this same footprint. Nothing for 58 years! And, yet, there are more people at St Andrew's today than ever before in our history, and the task of reaching out to new people is getting harder and harder. We must act.

Brothers and sisters, please, let's live up to the hopes and ambitions of former generations of St Andrew's church members, who somehow saw in this church "a house of prayer for all nations" (Isaiah 56:7). They dreamed that we would reach people from every nationality and send out believers from here to bless the world.

Our current site is not adequate for *current* ministry, especially the current kids ministry. I'll get Cath Ahern to speak to that in the coming weeks. But let me wind back and remind us of the purpose of our proposed property redevelopment, how our physical spaces assist our spiritual mission.

The fundamental idea of the 2020Vision is that there is a great disconnect between the 700+ adults and kids of St Andrew's and the 150,000 residents in a 10 minute drive of us. This disconnect is not just the result of their sin or our lack prayer and evangelism. It is also simply the result of a lack of 'touch points' between the church and the wider community. If St Andrew's were to disappear, who in the community would notice?!

Because of this lack of 'touch points', the wider community has little idea of the joy Christ brings to life, the spirit of friendship and community that overflows in this place, the intellectual stimulation the Christian faith brings, the practical love and support that is available here at St Andrew's—let alone the knowledge of the gospel of God's grace that inspires all these blessings.

The solution is not only to pray more and communicate Christ better (both of which we must do), but to 'lower the drawbridge' and transform ourselves into "a centre of community for Roseville and beyond", so that we become a locus of Christian education, friendship, social care and action, diversity, the arts, health, fun and, above all, worship—all

grounded in a confident, well-articulated conviction that Christ is Lord over all of life.

Picture the ministry and community going on in this place in 2022, Lord willing. Picture Toddlers Groups four mornings a week where kids play in safety and carers mingle in comfort. Picture three sessions of ESL each week, meeting in real classrooms with inbuilt technology. Picture being able to drop into church midweek with friends for a coffee and a muffin, while the kids enjoy some free-play in a dedicated area. Picture futsal and basketball competitions for youth. Picture evening seminars for adults in rooms that won't embarrass you. Picture enormous banquets for ourselves and the wider community. Picture an annual art competition and a short film festival, where we simultaneously encourage the arts and open up conversations about important matters (which the arts do so well).

These are the 'touch points' that will allow our neighbours and friends to glimpse the goodness of God in Christ which animates all of life.

Little of this is possible in the buildings faithfully given to us in the first 50 years of ministry in Roseville. After 58 years of nothing, it is surely time to do everything we can to build a new version of that "house of prayer for all nations", so that just as we have blessed

thousands of locals in our first 100 years, we will go on to bless tens of thousands in the next 100 years.
