FINANCIAL MATTERS

🕒 **Financial Update**

For the 3 months to March 2018 the total general offertory received was \$238,666 against a budget of \$260,875. We are therefore \$22,209 (8.5%) behind budget.

🕒 **How we can together meet our budget**

Two weeks ago we made an announcement about the 2018 Budget. Specifically, we highlighted the need for the general offertory to increase by 5% so that we can balance the budget and continue undertake the planned ministries and operations for 2018.

Everyone was given a rubber band, asked to put in on their wrist and not take it off until they had done the following:

1. Thought and prayed about their regular giving
2. Understood that the parish cannot function as planned without an average 5% increase in the general offertory
3. Made a conscious decision about what they will do, and most importantly,
4. Made the change if they can – be it through a regular electronic funds transfer or a weekly cash amount put into the bag, or both.

And for those who currently don't give anything, we made it clear that we don't want

them to increase their giving by 5%, but rather we would like the rubber band to act as a reminder to think and pray about starting regular financial support of the ministry at St Andrew's.

If you were at church 2 Sundays ago and have been through the 4 steps above, thank you.

If you were at church 2 Sundays ago and have not been through the 4 steps above, we ask you to do so.

If you were not at church on that Sunday, then we also ask you to go through the 4 steps above.
