Dear St Andrew's,

Those who were at the 10am, 5pm, 7pm and Youth Church services last Sunday will know that during each of the services, we launched the St Andrew's App for use on smartphones (both Apple and Android platforms).

In these times of email, websites, social media, sms, (plus the News and Sunday announcements), it is difficult to know which is the most efficient and effective way of communicating important information with each of the congregations. It is not uncommon for the church leadership to hear that parishioners were not aware of an upcoming event despite the numerous times we promote things across many of the communication platforms mentioned above. Given the busy and 'communication swamped' lives we find ourselves in today, this is understandable.

The St Andrew's leadership believe that this new St Andrew's app will help significantly in this area of communication. We want the app to be the **primary** method of notification for everyone (at least for the 10am, 5pm, 7pm and Youth congregations). The St Andrew's office will do our best at tempering how often we send out notifications so that you don't feel

bombarded. For the next few weeks we will still however send out app notifications early in the week advising that the sermon, small group questions and the weekly News have been uploaded to the app. Once everyone is familiar with this pattern of when these uploads occur, we will no longer send out a notification. This way, when you do receive a notification from the app, you will know that it is not just a 'regular' type of information notification but instead it is something that we would like you to take note of.

For the 8am congregation we will also still send out emails as we understand that many 8am members are not smartphone users. The success of the app will largely rely upon a high take-up of users. So, if you haven't already, please download the free app by searching 'St Andrew's Roseville' in the Apple store or the Google Play store.

On the display cupboard at the rear of the church you will find instructions on how to install and setup the app. It really is very easy!

If you have any difficulties installing or using the app, please contact the office - we will be happy to help get the app working for you!

## ANDREW AND STEPHANIE BROWNING



### 📍 Tanzania

Andrew and Stephanie Browning with children William and Christopher returned to Australia in late 2017 after serving in Arusha, Tanzania since 1999. Andrew was working at the Lutheran Mission Hospital and Stephanie set up and ran the Christ Church International School. Andrew plans to continue overseeing training in fistula surgery around Africa and South East Asia and traveling back to Africa 4 times a year to teach and to operate on fistula patients.

Praise God for Andrew's recent trip to Ethiopia and Uganda; that many women were operated on and that almost all were cured.

Pray for Andrew as he is now in South Sudan to open a new fistula unit in Juba. This is a

partnership with the Lutheran Church and it will be the first fistula camp. Pray for safety and that the patients won't be stopped from coming because of the conflict in the region.

Praise God for the new hospital in Barhir Dar, Ethiopia. There have been record numbers of women delivering in the new hospital unit and still no maternal deaths or fistula occurring. Please pray for more volunteers to come and help and for Dr Birhanu as he continues to learn obstetrics.

Pray for Andrew, Stephanie, William and Christopher as they visit many supporting churches in Australia; that they will be encouraged by these visits.

Pray for William, aged 12 and Christopher, aged 8 as they settle into life in Australia. They miss many things about life in Africa. Pray that they will make new friends and settle in well at school and at home.

Pray for the fundraising work for the Barbara May Foundation, dedicated to improving women's health in Africa.
