Given the busy and 'communication swamped' lives we find ourselves in today, this is understandable.


The St Andrew's smartphone app was launched recently and it is set to become the **primary** method of notification for St Andrew's events and information.

Soon, notifications from the app, will not be for 'regular' information like uploads of the Weekly News and sermons, but instead for things for you to especially take note of.

The success of the app will largely rely upon a high take-up of users. So, if you haven't already, please download the free app by

searching 'St Andrew's Roseville' in the Google Play store or the Apple store.

Please note that in 'Settings' it is important to have the first 3 options chosen (sliders to the right) as well as any other congregations and groups that you and your family are part of.

FINANCIAL UPDATE

➤ **General Offertory**

For the 5 months to May 2018 the total general offertory received was \$405,053 against a budget of \$434,792. We are therefore approximately \$30,000 or 7% behind budget.

➤ **How together we can meet our budget**

Several weeks ago we highlighted the 5% increase on previous year general offertory that was approved by the Parish earlier in the year. This 5% increase is needed so that we can balance the budget and continue to undertake the planned ministries and operations for 2018. We appealed to each member of St Andrew's to:

- Think and pray about their current level of regular giving
- Understand that the parish cannot function as planned without an average 5% increase in the general offertory
- Make a conscious decision about what they will do to assist the Parish in meeting its 2018 general offertory target.

So, if you haven't already done so, we ask that you take some time to consider this request.

For those who currently don't give anything and are regular members of St Andrew's, can we ask that you consider making it a priority

(within your means) to start supporting the ministry.

Details for regular giving are found on the back page of this News sheet each and every week. If you prefer, you can support the Parish via the collection that takes place during each of the services on a Sunday.
