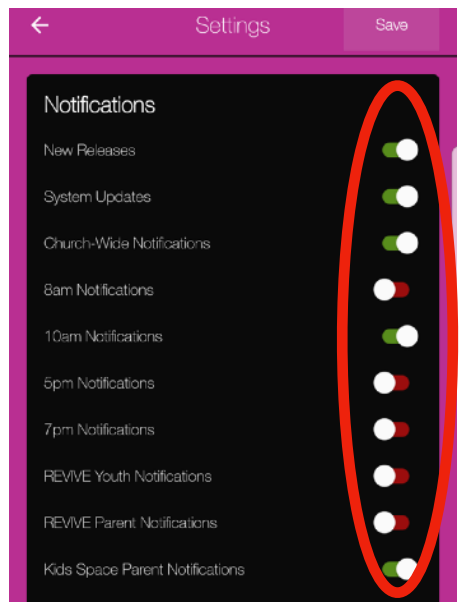
The St Andrew's smartphone app was launched recently and it is set to become the **primary** method of notification for St Andrew's events and information.

Soon, notifications from the app, will not be for 'regular' information like uploads of the Weekly News and sermons, but instead for things for you to especially take note of.

The success of the app will largely rely upon a high take-up of users. So, if you haven't already, please download the free app by

ARCHBISHOP MASIMANGO KATANDA

Pray for Archbishop Masimango Katanda in the Anglican Church in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Praise God for the Church of Congo. Despite the insecurity in Eastern part of the country, churches continue to witness and many are coming to the faith by receiving Christ in their life.

We Thank the Roseville Parish trustees for the financial support to the Diocese of Kindu. Money sent has been used in Evangelism and Mission also for promoting local church leaders training and refresh courses.

Pray for peace in DR Congo as the Presidential election is to be held this year.

Much remains to be done to ensure a fair and successful election process. Pray for the majority parties in currently in power and for the opposition parties and that the election will be fair and without violence.

Pray for a positive outcome of the lobbying for emergency assistance to the Dioceses of the Anglican Province of Congo where thousands of displaced people seek refuge in a number of parishes, especially in Boga, Kamango, Aru, Beni, Goma, Bukavu, Kalemie, and Kindu. There are army groups operating in the area and regular fighting between them.

Pray for the Diocese of Butembo as a new diocese has been created, the Diocese of Beni. Synod will be held in the last week of July. Pray for a peace as tension has been raised relating to a potential candidate for Bishop. Pray for the wisdom of Bishop Isesomo during the Synod session.
