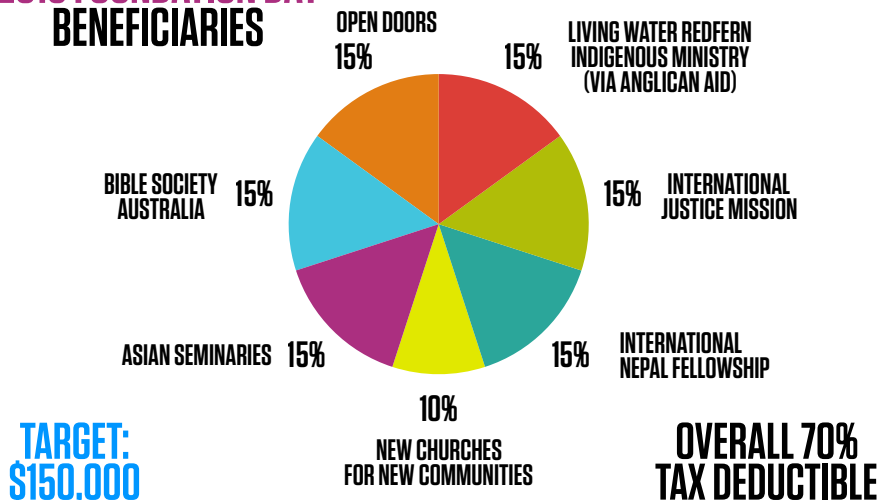

## AFRICAN ENTERPRISE



### 🌍 Africa

*Over the years, St Andrew's staff have been involved in short-term missions with African Enterprise, teaching Bible College courses in Africa. St Andrew's has also supported the work of African Enterprise financially and in prayer.*

Pray for peace and unity among the different races in South Africa, particularly in the Church.

Pray that God will fulfil all His expectations for African Enterprise in serving the Lord as they evangelise the cities of Africa through word and deed in partnership with local churches.

Pray for God's blessing on African Enterprise's Lusaka Leadership Initiative, beginning soon in Zambia. Pray for all those speaking at and leading the Lusaka Mission; that they will feel the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
