🕒 Africa & Australia

Andrew and Stephanie Browning with their children William and Christopher returned to Australia in late 2017 after serving in Arusha, Tanzania since 1999. Andrew was working at the Lutheran Mission Hospital and Stephanie set up and ran the Christ Church International School. Andrew continues to oversee training in fistula surgery around Africa and South East Asia, traveling to Africa 4 times a year to teach and to operate on fistula patients.

Praise God for a safe trip to Tanzania in August to two hospitals where Andrew provided training, operated on 15 'incurable patients' and then saw another 23 patients in Arusha.

Thank God also for the operations that Andrew has also recently completed in Tanzania, Uganda and Ethiopia.

Pray for Birhanu and Negash as they run the hospital in Barhirdar, Ethiopia. Thank God that the government has recently granted another three year licence for the hospital.

Praise God for the volunteers who have recently been involved in the work in Africa: Drs Sam and Lisa and Sr Kathy Hay. Pray also for the ongoing training and support for the midwives in the surrounding nine health centres around the hospital in Barhirdar.

Pray for the Browning family as they continue to settle in to life in Australia. Pray for Andrew as he looks for medical work here that enables him to continue his medical trips to Africa.

Praise God for the opportunity for Andrew to speak to various groups in Australia recently, telling the stories of God's goodness and what He has been doing in the world. Pray that Andrew will be a faithful witness.
