FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

Dear St Andrews,

As another new year unfolds, we have again seen an influx of new people attending services and joining our church; a great start to what we hope will be a wonderful 2019 for St Andrew's Roseville.

Thank you for your prayers for my trip to the Middle East last week. It was quite something! I look forward to reporting back about how well your tax dollars are being used to support Syrian refugees.

One of my final duties as your Rector will be to chair our AGM on Monday 18 March at 7pm. It is crucial to ensure that we have the right priorities and decision-makers in place to guide our church through the exciting year ahead. Key to the AGM is voting-in members of the church for Parish Council and Wardens. Parish Council *governs* the finances and property of St Andrew's, and provides key counsel to the Senior Minister on all ministry matters. Wardens (3 individuals) are part of the Parish Council but have the added duty of *managing* church finances and property. We will not elect Parish Nominators this year, since those elected last year are

already 'engaged' in the process of finding a new Rector. Please continue to prayer for them.

If you are interested in taking up the role of Warden or Parish Councillor, please ask another member of the church to nominate you. If you can think of someone who would be great for one of these positions, please speak to that person and, if they are agreeable, nominate them. Send all nominations to

Please note, the diocesan rules state that if you nominate someone, you must also be present at the AGM.

At the AGM we also approve the proposed budget for 2019, which calls for a 5% increase on 2018, and we will receive important updates about finances, the property vision, and other matters. There will also be an opportunity for you to give feedback. Please pray for the AGM. Please come to the AGM. Anyone may attend, but in order to vote you must: (a) be 18 years old or over, (b) be baptised (in any Christian denomination), and (c) have attended St Andrew's Roseville for at least the last three months.
