4 weeks beginning Thu 6th Jun | 7:30pm


At St Andrew's Roseville

### E-waste recycling at St Andrew's

Please bring any old household batteries, mobile phones and accessories, and used printer cartridges to the collection bins at the entrance to the church hall.

Last month we delivered well over 500 old batteries for recycling. Over the last 5 years the St Andrew's Roseville community have saved approx. 5000 batteries from going to landfill – fantastic!

As the battery casings corrode in landfill, chemicals such as cadmium, lead, mercury, nickel, and lithium leach into the soil, and eventually into waterways. These absorbed upwards through the food chain.


