PLEASE NOTE - PARKING ON HILL ST

A parishioner from our 10am service was recently booked for parking in the bus zone on a Sunday on the Eastern side of Hill St (the non-railway side), near the corner of Victoria Ave. Please note that this bus zone is a 7 day/24hr restriction unlike some of the other bus zones on the other side of Hill St. It would seem that many parishioners do park in this area and it has not been policed for many years. ☛ Africa

Pray for the Soweto Kayole Primary Health Care Clinic, a community project established by African Enterprise Kenya in 1996. The clinic offers various outpatient and emergency services to communities who cannot afford to access quality medical care and are often forced to turn to ill equipped and unlicensed medical facilities.

Pray for the doctors, medical staff and directors at the clinic; that they can continue to serve God and their community through the skills and care they have been gifted.

Pray for new and updated equipment that is needed to provide more holistic care and services within the facility.

Pray for wisdom in addressing competing interests for land versus medical care, especially as these issues are currently before the courts.

Thank God for the hundreds of lives that has been transformed over the years through the Ghana Street Children Apprenticeship Project (SCAP). Pray that the children trained in the SCAP will thrive spiritually and economically and that their lives will be transformed forever.

Pray for protection for the mission team as they minister in Mombasa, Kenya in later June. Some of the areas in Mombasa are targets and hiding places of terrorists groups.

Pray for the 3,000 mission volunteers that African Enterprise will train and equip. Pray that churches from all over the country will send their members to Mombasa.

DOWNLOAD THE ST ANDREW'S APP

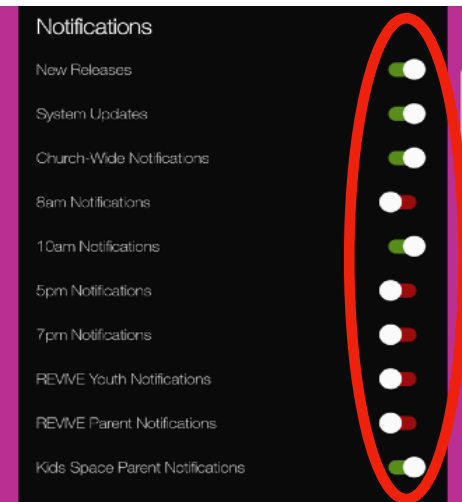
The St Andrew's smartphone app is now the **primary** method of notification for St Andrew's events and information.
