FROM THE THE WARDENS

Dear St Andrew's,

We would like to share with an update on the financial health of our parish budget.

As many of you may know, the funds required to operate the parish comes from within our church community. It is primarily used to pay the staff on our wonderful ministry teams, our day-to-day bills such as electricity, repairs and so on, with 10% of the general offertory received allocated to support our mission partners.

We are so grateful for how well God has blessed us financially at St Andrew's over the years, and the ways that these blessings have helped us to impact lives not only in our community at Roseville, but also around the world.

However friends, we are currently facing a challenge. As at the end of the May, we have found ourselves with shortfall in general offertory of \$50,000.

We know with God's help, that we can find a way to catch up, and part of this is reaching out to our church family to ask for your assistance.

If you are currently giving electronically, which we know many of you do, and if you have not already done so in 2019, we are

asking you to consider increasing your regular giving by 5%.

If you are currently not giving, and you are in a financial position to do so, please prayerfully consider making this a part of your routine - it's as simple as jumping onto your online bank account, setting up a recurring transfer, and entering the details below:


