Open Doors partners with local churches in over 70 countries to help advance the gospel and strengthen persecuted Christians through Bibles, training and practical support.

Praise God that a lady in Vietnam who had attended Open Doors' persecution preparation training and was able to respond well when authorities raided her Bible study.

Pray that God will use the current pressure on the Saudi Arabian Government to release imprisoned human rights activists and Christians.

Pray that Open Doors can continue to run youth camps that strengthen young Christians in Brunei.

Pray for the man in India who miraculously survived when his Hindu neighbours tried to drown him for becoming a Christian. Pray for the family to be united soon and praise God that Open Doors could practically support them.

Pray for the pastor in Vietnam who received medical training from Open Doors so that he can care for his community. Pray for many opportunities for him to share Jesus with non-Christians in his village.

Pray that the Bible will be fully translated into the local language in Maldives.

Pray for Christians in Brunei as Sharia (Islamic) law has been fully implemented in that country. This allows adulterers to be stoned to death and thieves punished with amputation. Pray the church won't be afraid, but will continue sharing the gospel and that their sultan will come to know Jesus.

Pray for young people in Myanmar who are affected by drug and alcohol abuse; that they will find freedom and have their needs met in Jesus.
