FROM THE WARDENS

🕒 **Property Redevelopment Update**

A number of parishioners have asked “what is happening with the property development?” This is a good question and we apologise for the lack of recent updates about such an important project for St Andrew's and for God's Kingdom.

The Wardens believe it is appropriate to wait until Rev Mal York begins in early September before making any further big moves on the property redevelopment project, including fundraising. Given that we will be drawing from our community financially and through prayer, the sheer logistics of living through a building renovation, the added pressure to our staff teams and that ultimately Mal will be leading us through this time, it's appropriate that we give Mal the opportunity to guide us and to provide his own input. Mal is already getting up to speed with our budgets and building plans, and he will be ready to hit the ground running in September.

It was decided in early 2018 by the senior leadership team, the Wardens and Parish Council to divide the project into stages, rather than developing the site all at once. A motion was considered at the Parish AGM held in March 2018 that the property redevelopment be divided into 2, possibly 3

stages. The motion was passed. We returned to the architectural firm and asked them to redraw the plans to allow us to do so. We will be starting with the hall and Kids Space (Sunday School) area, being the space that is considered to be where there is most critical need. We will also construct at least some of the underground parking which will be in the area that forms the building foundations for the hall. All of these changes required us to resubmit plans to Council - and praise God, we received council approval on 26 June 2019.

In terms of where we are up to with fundraising for the property redevelopment - we have currently raised \$4.7 million from the generosity of our parish - with our target being just under \$9 million for the completion of Stage 1 (when costed in March 2018). Approximately \$0.7 million has already been spent for architectural plans, consultants fees and the DA approval process. Most of the funds so far spent are costs that are included in the \$9 million target. We therefore presently have approximately \$4 million available in cash. Additionally, there is a significant amount pledged but not yet received; understandably, parishioners have been waiting until greater clarity of timing of the

build is known. Given that a significant amount of time has passed since these pledges were made, it is considered prudent to not promote a pledged figure as some parishioners' circumstances may have changed since pledges were made.

We are grateful for the ways that God has moved you to contribute financially to the building project so far, and continue to be encouraged by the community of St Andrew's willingness to invest in the future of our church buildings.

Please continue to pray for Parish Council, the Wardens, the Building Committee, our staff, Mal York and all who are involved in the property development process; that they will make wise decisions and be faithful stewards of the resources of the parish.
