## ANDREW AND STEPHANIE BROWNING



### ➡ Africa & Australia

Andrew and Stephanie Browning with their children William and Christopher returned to Australia in late 2017 after serving in Arusha, Tanzania since 1999. Andrew was working at the Lutheran Mission Hospital and Stephanie set up and ran the Christ Church International School. Andrew continues to oversee training in fistula surgery around Africa and South East Asia, traveling to Africa 4 times a year to teach and to operate on fistula patients.

Earlier this year Andrew was awarded the Member (AM) In the General Division Of The Order Of Australia for significant service to the international community through the provision of obstetric care to women in

Africa. At the time he said that it made him “realise that many people in Australia are concerned about underprivileged women on the other side of the world they will probably never meet. At times the task ahead to help these women can seem overwhelming, but knowing that the work we are doing is respected, gives me great encouragement.” Pray for Andrew, Stephanie and their family as they continue in this work.

Pray for Andrew’s upcoming trip to Africa in August; that it will be a safe and effective trip, giving life-saving care to many.

Praise for the ongoing work of the hospitals that Andrew works at and for the many thousands of women who were helped last year. Pray that God’s name will be glorified through this ministry.

Pray for the volunteer staff scattered over Ethiopia and Tanzania; that they remain faithful and safe.

Pray for the maternity hospital that is planned for South Sudan. Pray that God will provide the funds if it’s His will for this project to go ahead.

Pray for Christ Church International School, for new Preschool and Year 5 teachers to join the team. Pray for all the teachers returning to the school in August.
