FROM THE WARDENS

🔗 Financial Update

Those who attended any of our services last Sunday will recall that the sermon challenged us as followers of Christ regarding our financial generosity to God's work; a generosity that responds to the grace and riches God has given us. The sermon also included an outline of the church's current shortfall in general offertory as well as the need to help fund the additional cost of our new Rector commencing in September this year (much sooner than anticipated when the budget was prepared, though grateful we are to have Mal start so soon)!

During Q&A at the 10am service, one parishioner texted, pledging \$1,000 to help meet the shortfall, and challenged others to do the same. Thankfully, some others have also responded generously since Sunday - praise God.

To reiterate the need, to the end of July 2019, our budget position has remained largely unchanged since we provided our last financial update in April. Unfortunately, general offertory receipts have not increased by the 5% that was in the budget approved by the parish at the March AGM. In fact, the amount of general offertory received to the end of July 2019 is \$581,000 and the amount received for the same 7 month period to July

2018 was \$582,000. This demonstrates that we have not achieved the 5% uplift required.

So, to the end of July, our general offertory received is approximately \$44,000 below budget. For the same 7 month period our expenses are closely aligned with our budget; although the budget did assume that our new Rector would commence in 2020, rather than in September 2019.

To meet our plan and to ensure the ongoing smooth operations of the parish, including having sufficient funds to pay all our staff, we will need to see a combination of increases in our regular offertory receipts and some "one off" boosts. Please prayerfully consider if you are in a position to do either or both.

INTERNATIONAL NEPAL FELLOWSHIP



➡ Nepal

International Nepal Fellowship (INF) is a Christian mission that serves the physical and spiritual needs of poor and disadvantaged Nepali people, and supports the Nepali church.

With the onset of the monsoon, parts of Nepal have been seriously affected by flooding and landslides. Tragically, at least 67 people have died so far, and more than 10,000 people have been displaced. Flooding has also destroyed crops, homes and vital infrastructure. Pray for health, safety and hope for all affected, for effective coordination of relief efforts and for strength and skill for all those responding.

Pray for INF as they provide shelter relief in one particularly badly-affected district. Pray also for the long-term rebuilding of these communities.

After a period of significant difficulty for expats trying to renew their visas, resulting in

some needing to temporarily leave Nepal, there seems to be some improvement. Praise God for these improvements and pray that visa renewal processes will be smooth for any expats serving with INF.

Pray for INF's Green Pastures Hospital, as well as its two regional hospitals. Pray that patients will receive the physical and spiritual care that they need, and that staff will be filled with compassion as they care for patients.

Pray for INF's community development work in the remote district of Jumla, in western Nepal. Pray for staff as they do the hard, slow work of working alongside poor communities. Pray for communities as they work together to tackle poverty and injustice; that their work will be fruitful.
