FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

It was wonderful to be a part of my first Foundation Day last Sunday. After hearing a report on the day of how last year's Foundation Day beneficiaries were blessed by the funds that were raised, I praise God for the way St Andrew's so generously supported last year's Foundation Day.

Last year, a total of \$250,000 was raised shared amongst several beneficiaries. We supported *Living Waters*, an Indigenous church in Redfern and *International Justice Mission (IJM)* who help free people from slavery. We also supported *Bible Society* as they shared the love of Jesus with prisoners in South Africa. We supported *New Churches for New Communities* and our money has helped Stanhope Gardens Anglican Church start construction of their building! Our 2018 Foundation Day fundraising also went towards the work of *Open Doors* who support the persecuted church in over 70 countries around the world. We also supported *China Partnership* who train pastors and church planters in China as well as *International Nepal Fellowship (INF)* who serve the physical and spiritual needs of the poor and disadvantaged in Nepal.

This year, our aim is to raise at least \$225,000.

With these funds we will continue our support of IJM, Living Waters, Open Doors, China Partnership, Bible Society and New Churches for New Communities.

In addition, this year we will also be supporting the Barbara May Foundation, who provide medical aid to women in Africa, in countries like South Sudan and Tanzania, and the Andrew's Hall redevelopment in Melbourne. CMS are upgrading their training facilities in Melbourne and through this, will continue to train many people in cross cultural ministry.

And finally, our Foundation Day funds will support Local Youth Initiatives, enabling us to work with other churches to reach out to youth in the local community. A recent example of this was UNITED that saw over 200 non-churched youth come to Chatswood Concourse to hear about Jesus.
