In an effort to reduce waste going to landfill, we are encouraged during this coming week to reflect on recycling in our homes and businesses.

Just a few months ago Stuart Holman reminded us that we, as custodians of God's creation, have a clear responsibility to care for the environment.

During National Recycling Week, remember to assess what you can recycle at home or work. Batteries, phones, toner cartridges can be deposited in the St Andrew's e-waste containers in the church hall foyer. Postage stamps can be placed in the Stamps collection box at the rear of the church to support CMS, and soon, milk bottle tops and bread tags will be able to be deposited in a new recycling container in the hall.

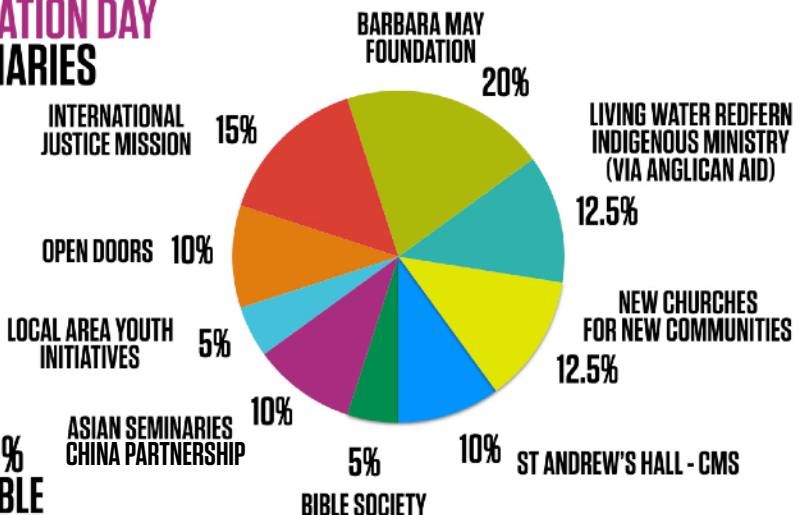

INTERNATIONAL NEPAL FELLOWSHIP



➔ Nepal

International Nepal Fellowship (INF) is a Christian mission that serves the physical and spiritual needs of poor and disadvantaged Nepali people, and supports the Nepali church.

Praise God for the completion of the Pastoral Care Centre, the ongoing building project at INF's Hospital, Green Pastures. The new centre will further enable INF to continue placing spiritual care at the heart of their work with patients, providing a much-needed space for pastoral care and counselling. It will also provide Christian staff with spaces to gather and pray, and be a space for significant events open to the whole hospital e.g. Christmas. Pray that it will enable more people to experience God's love and goodness while at Green Pastures.

Pray for the processing of visas for INF's expatriate workers in Nepal. A number of

individuals/families have faced significant delays, meaning some have even had to leave the country temporarily. Pray that visas will be granted quickly and with minimal disruption.

Pray for more workers needed in areas such as teaching, community development, and Human Resources. Pray that God will raise up people to serve with INF.

Pray for INF's work focusing on empowering women and improving gender equality in Nepal, including through addressing the significant and very sensitive issue of domestic and family violence. Pray for peace and justice for survivors of violence, and a groundswell of community action and change.

Pray for a group of nine Australians, including Kate Clark from St Andrew's Roseville, who will be doing the Annapurna Base Camp trek this month to raise funds for Green Pastures Hospital and INF's health work. Pray for a safe trek and for generous supporters. You can support Kate's fundraising trek at www.tiny.cc/inf trek
