FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

Welcome to church today - it is wonderful that you can join us. If you are joining us for the first time, today we are finishing our series that has focused on 2 Timothy, 'Foundations of Gospel Ministry'. During this series we have seen how in his letter to Timothy, Paul exhorts Timothy to align the church in Ephesus to the teachings of Jesus

In today's sermon, we will start to look at the ministries here at St Andrew's Roseville and ask ourselves how we will continue to align ourselves and our church with Paul's instructions in 2 Timothy. So it will be less about dealing with the passage and more about some initial thinking on the vision for the ministry here in 2020 and the years that follow. As the future unfolds, it will be a joy to see God continue to use his people (perhaps in some new ways) for his glory.

Speaking of God and his people here at Roseville, I want to bring to a close our recent Foundation Day appeal. Since the announcement of the total funds raised last Sunday, more pledges and funds have come in; the result now stands at over \$239,000! I just want to say that this is such an

awesome reflection of the wonderful generosity of the saints at St Andrew's.

The money will be distributed to the various mission agencies that we promoted on Foundation Day, as follows:
