🕒 Tanzania & Ethiopia

Andrew and Stephanie Browning with their children William and Christopher returned to Australia in late 2017 after serving in Arusha, Tanzania since 1999. Andrew was working at the Lutheran Mission Hospital and Stephanie set up and ran the Christ Church International School. Andrew continues to oversee training in fistula surgery around Africa and South East Asia, traveling to Africa 4 times a year to teach and to operate on fistula patients, funded by the Barbara May Foundation.

Pray for Ethiopia as there is widespread unrest and conflict around the country.

Praise God for the new director of the hospital in Arusha, Monica Ndege. Monica comes with a wealth of experience and wisdom. Pray for strength for her as she begins this new role.

Praise God for the team who are doing so well in the hospital in Barhirdar, Ethiopia with hundreds of women delivering safely every month.

Pray for the patients who were recently treated in Nepal - many have awful stories of neglect. Pray for healing, physically as well as emotionally and spiritually.

Praise God for a partnership between the Lutheran Church in the USA and people in South Sudan. They are partnering with the Barbara May Foundation to construct a new maternity hospital in South Sudan, hopefully to open by August.

Pray for the school in Arusha, for good governance and some potential links with the Association of Christian Schools.

Pray for Steph as she sets up a company here in Australia to support and recruit the teachers.

Pray for the new family coming from America soon to teach at the school, for smooth processing of visas and work permits.
