Dear St Andrew's,

When Covid-19 first hit, I thought that the change to online church was going to be hard. However, thanks to the staff team that we have at St Andrew's it wasn't as difficult as I expected and our online services have gone well.

Now that we are planning a path to meeting together, I find that this is even trickier than taking church online. So, I want to outline my thoughts on how we will do this.

This Sunday, we will be doing a 'dry run' of having people meeting on site again. The services will cater both to those in the church building and watching at home and will be live-streamed at **9am and 4:30pm**. ***Please note the change of time for the evening service.*** We believe that 4.30pm will be a better time for those who will be meeting in one another's homes.

As I have outlined recently (and further explained in the 'Next Steps' video on our Youtube channel:

www.tiny.cc/StA-youtube) we are encouraging parishioners to meet with others in their homes to watch the live-stream

services at 9am and 4:30pm **or** at a later time if that is more convenient.

Early this week we will launch a sign-up system (via an email and sign-up form) for those who are keen to attend our services on site. We will then allocate attendance on a rotating basis - we won't be able to have people turning up

As we gather together on site again there will be some noticeable changes: increased signage, temperature checks, hand sanitiser, a check-in system and appropriately spaced seating. We won't be able to have congregational singing, hand out bibles or News booklets, or join together in morning tea and supper after the services.

We will adhere to the Government's requirements with limited numbers to gather on site as well encouraging in house churches until we can all meet back on site. Everyone meeting together on site may not be allowed for some time so we believe that this is a sustainable approach until all restrictions are lifted.

This is a fully opt-in digital system **only for adults** who attend St Andrew's.

Please note that to join the Directory, you need to set up a username and password by clicking on the link in the Member Directory email that has been sent to you. The email will be addressed to 'Dear [YourFirstName]' as it has a link for you to click on that is unique to you.

Follow the instructions in the email for how to set up your profile - *it's very easy!* - and use the Member Directory in the Elvanto App (this is the simplest way to use it). You can also view the instructions with 'how to' screenshots at www.standrews.net.au/downloads/MemberDirectoryOpt-in.pdf If you choose not to have the app, you can still be part of and use the Member Directory via a web browser (eg Chrome, Safari etc) at www.standrews.elvanto.com.au

If you choose to be part of the Member Directory:

You can also choose whether any or all of the contact details listed below are visible to others from St Andrew's who use the directory:

- 🔗 your email address
- 🔗 your mobile phone number
- 🔗 your home phone number (if you have one)

No other details will be visible.

You can add a profile photo if you want to.

Once you are part of the Member Directory you can opt-out at any time or make any of your contact details hidden.

The Member Directory is being rolled out to enhance the ability for St Andrew's Roseville members to be connected with one another. It is not to be used for any other purpose including, solicitation, commercial gain or mass communication.

INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE MISSION



📍 **Australia and International**

International Justice Mission (IJM), works collaboratively with local partners to create justice system transformation.

Pray for the restoration of survivors of cybersex trafficking in the Philippines. After a rescue operation, although the children are out of immediate danger, the trauma runs deep. Unfortunately, there are more children needing care than there are government social workers.

Praise God that IJM have been able to foster relationships between the police and the local grassroots justice centres in Kenya that are doing so much good work monitoring police abuses and supporting survivors. Pray that this relationship will be strengthened and that police will sincerely engage with the justice centres in dialogues that will help ensure policing is responsible, professional and truly in service to the community.

Pray for the IJM teams in Latin America as they walk alongside survivors and IJM

partners during the pandemic. Many countries in the region are struggling to contain major outbreaks, and experts wonder if Latin America could become the new epicentre for the pandemic. Pray that victims of violence will be able to break the silence and ask for help in this time, and pray for police officers around the region to be able to respond quickly to protect and restore them.

Pray for the impact of the recently released IJM global study on online sexual exploitation of children in the Philippines. Pray that governments and tech businesses will take the recommendations for protecting children from this violent crime, and that the children who need rescue now will be protected by a system that works.

Pray for God's protection and swift recovery for several IJM teams who were recently affected by a massive cyclone in South Asia. Pray for IJM as they try to reconnect with survivors across the affected area to ensure they are also safe and secure, and pray for government officials working to reach families in need.
