🔗 Keeping in touch

Thank you to everyone who has joined in the St Andrew's Roseville Member Directory in the past couple week. With members in the Directory from all 4 congregations, it is growing each day. This is a fully opt-in digital system **only for adults** who attend St Andrew's.

Please note that to join the Directory, you need to set up a unique username and a password by clicking on a Member Directory link that has been emailed to you - *please see a recent Friday Weekly News email for this as the links are only valid for 14 days from when the email is sent.*

Any emails about the Member Directory that specifically have your first name in them will have a link for you to click on that is unique to you.

Follow the instructions in the email for how to set up your profile - *it's very easy!* - and use the Member Directory in the Elvanto App (this is the simplest way to use it). You can also view the instructions with 'how to' screenshots at www.standrews.net.au/downloads/MemberDirectoryOpt-in.pdf

If you choose not to have the app, you can still be part of, and use, the Member Directory via a web browser (eg Chrome, Safari etc) at www.standrews.elvanto.com.au

If you choose to be part of the Member Directory:

- 🔗 your name will appear in the directory,
- 🔗 the congregation you attend will be visible

You can also choose whether any or all of the contact details listed below are visible to others from St Andrew's who use the directory:

- 🔗 your email address
- 🔗 your mobile phone number
- 🔗 your home phone number (if you have one)

No other details will be visible.

You can add a profile photo if you want to.

Once you are part of the Member Directory you can opt-out at any time or make any of your contact details hidden.

The Member Directory is being rolled out to enhance the ability for St Andrew's Roseville members to be connected with one another. It is not to be used for any other purpose including, solicitation, commercial gain or mass communication.
