International Justice Mission (IJM), works collaboratively with local partners to create justice system transformation. Here are some prayer points.

Australia

Pray for the Premier and state government of NSW to proclaim the NSW Modern Slavery Act 2018 without further delay.

Africa & Europe

Praise God for an opportunity to provide police in Uganda with a victim-sensitive interviewing space near the temporary shelter in Kampala that IJM has helped to refurbish.

Latin America

Pray for protection and resilience for those who work to combat all forms of violence against women and children in the Northern Triangle of Central America (Guatemala, El Salvador and Honduras).

South Asia

Praise God for the recent rescue of a 10 year-old boy from a goat farm. He had been enslaved as a shepherd at the farm for the past two years after his family fell into deep poverty following the death of his mother.

South-East Asia

Pray that God will continue to lead IJM teams to new cases and rescues for those trapped in forced labour (slavery) in the Thai fishing and seafood industry.
