LIFE ANGLICAN MARSDEN PARK

Rev. Mark Collins is the Lead Pastor/Planter at Life Anglican Marsden Park, a vibrant growing church community in Western Sydney.

Give thanks for new people joining the church at Life Anglican Marsden Park.

Pray for the new 4pm service which started originally due to COVID 19 restrictions however will continue due to the growth in the morning service. Pray for the new service as it needs to take on a life of its own.

Give thanks for the growth in the morning service which is back to a similar size that it was at the start of 2020, even with a new service in the afternoon.
