Undeceptions, led by John Dickson, publicly advocates for the Christian faith, and helps other Christians to do the same.

Please pray that John and the team will be able to fulfill the many commitments and deadlines over the coming months, as John and Buff host their dear friends Ben and Karen while Ben receives palliative care in the Dickson home.

Pray for the Promoting the Gospel lecture series at Ridley College, as John flies down to Melbourne each Wed/Thurs to teach aspiring gospel workers.

Pray for John's Sunday evangelistic preaching at St Matthew's Manly over the coming two Sundays—that people will bring friends and neighbours, and that the gospel will be clear and compelling.
