FOUNDATION DAY - 31 OCTOBER 2021

On Sunday October 31st we will be celebrating our 2021 Foundation Day – an annual event during which we recognise and give thanks for God's incredible blessings to us, both spiritual and material. Everything we own comes from Him. Giving thanks, we especially look beyond ourselves in support of mission and aid causes through prayer and financial support.

Having emerged from a second wave of COVID-19 we can be so thankful for the blessings of peace and prosperity and for our advanced medical and health systems that have minimised its impact. With the technology available and through our passionate ministry teams we have remained connected even though we can't meet face to face. Praise God!

In the lead up to Foundation Day 2021 please consider how we may reflect God's love through our blessing of others facing tough challenges with poor health, poverty and constraints to their ministries where the effects of the Pandemic have been far greater.

This year we hope to raise at least \$235,000 of which 80% will be tax deductible. Therefore each donor will receive a tax receipt for 80% of the amount donated.

The projects we are supporting this year have close associations with St Andrew's and a balance between gospel mission and Christ centred aid.


Each of the five beneficiaries will receive an equal share of the amount raised.

Saturday Morning Bushwalk - 30 October

Enjoy a morning bushwalk in Garigal National Park in the Forestville area with other church members. We will begin the walk on the Carroll Creek Track, then quickly join the forested Casuarina Track and follow it down to Davidson Park and Middle Harbour. The route is then along the Lyrebird Track until it meets the Carroll Creek Track which is followed back to the start. The walk is around 9.5km and will take up to 3 hours. Moderate fitness is required. Please wear appropriate footwear and bring water, hat and sunscreen. Meet at the corner of Ferguson St and Woodlands Rd Forestville by 7:30am where there is plenty of street parking.

2 Zambia's Child Gala Dinner - 30 October


