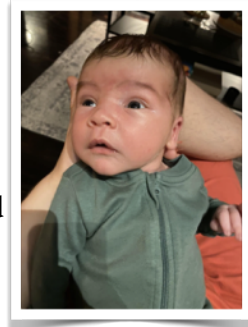


BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

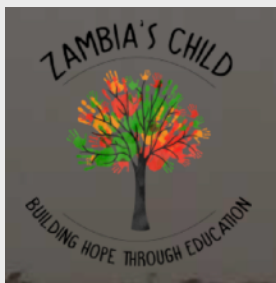

A reminder that there is a recycling station in the breezeway passageway into the Church hall. SATURDAY AFTERNOON BUSH WALK

When: Saturday May 18, 1:00pm

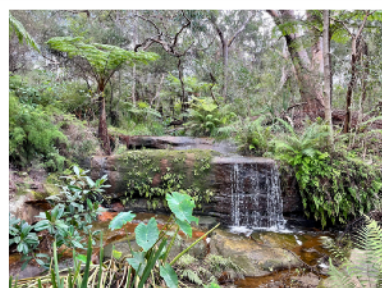
Where: Meet at the Main Entrance of the Park (near the dam wall), 112 King St Manly Vale

There is free parking near the end of King St, 100m before you enter the Manly Dam State Park. With a Northern Beaches Parking Permit you will be able to park for free at the first parking area past the entrance gate.

It is about a 7.5km walk, taking up to 3 hours. Moderate fitness is required. Please wear appropriate sturdy footwear and bring water, hat and sunscreen.

To continue fellowship with your fellow walkers, please bring a snack during a short break during the walk.
